people who care about him.



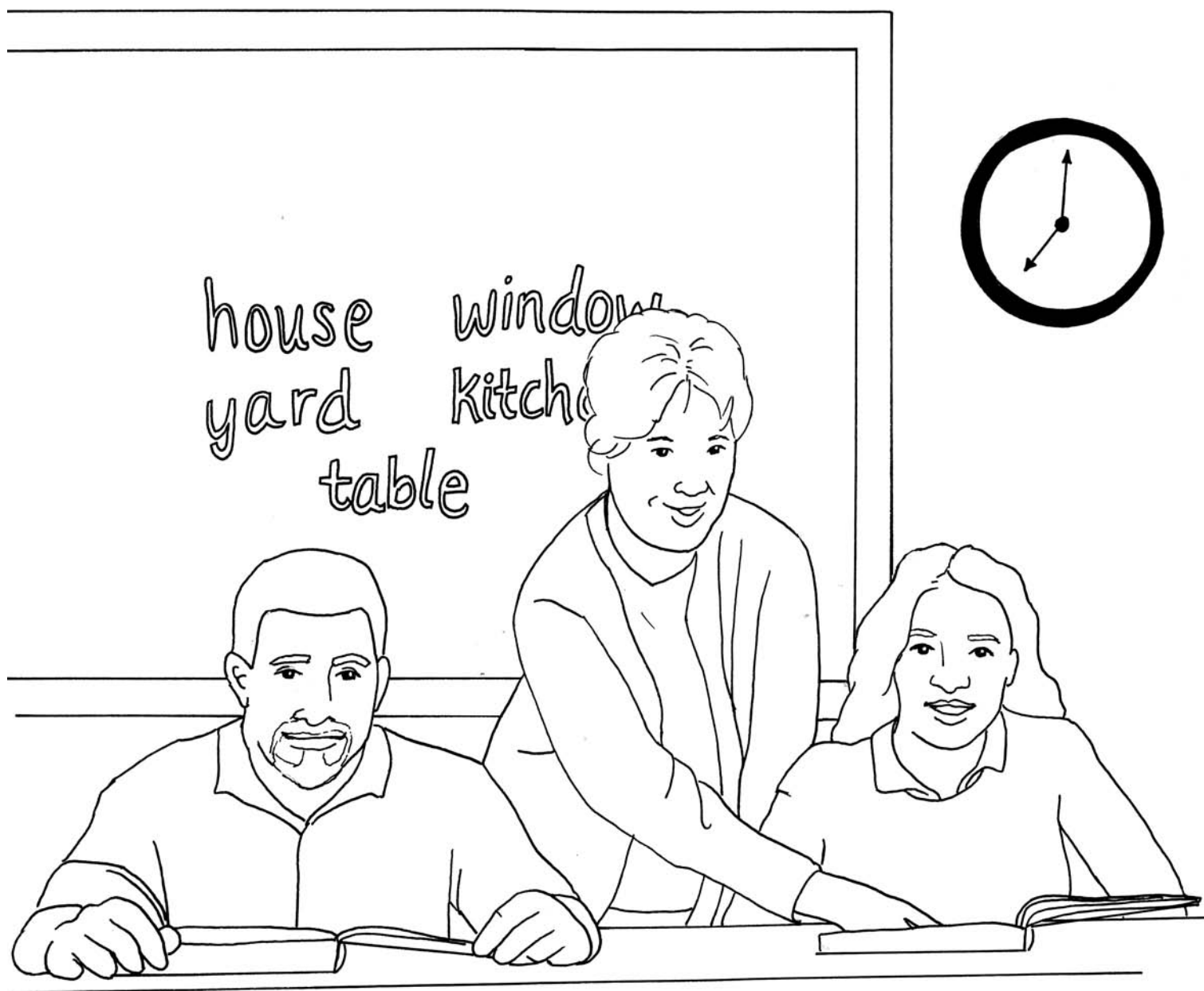
My neighbor Mari is a Christian, like me. She comes from Iraq. That's a long way from here. But there was fighting in her city. Her family had to leave.

It's hard for Mari at school, because she didn't speak English before she came here. I am helping her.



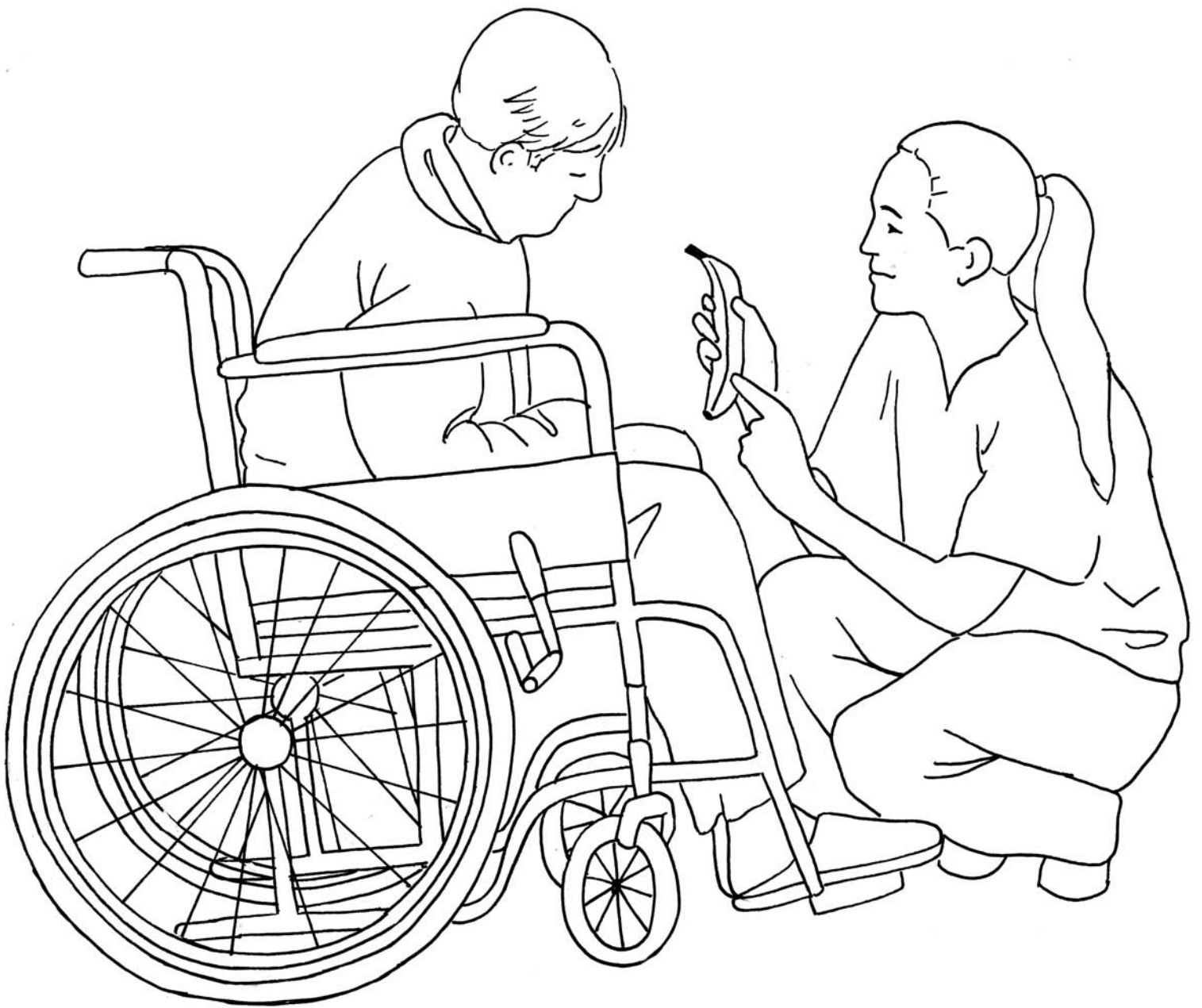
Her mom and dad go to school to learn English too.
